

A MAIL REPLY FROM INDIAN EMBASSY IN GERMANY

1. Question - What is the duration of a Medical Doctor Degree or MBBS in Germany for local students?

A regularly structured degree course in medicine takes six years and is completed by a state exam (Staatsexamen), with which one obtains a license to practice as a physician (approbation).

2. Question - What is the duration of a Medical Doctor Degree or MBBS in Germany for foreign students?

Same as above.

3. Question - What is the Language of instruction for a Medical Doctor Degree or MBBS in Germany (English or other language)?

Medical education in Germany takes place solely with German as the medium of instruction.

4. Question - What is the provision & Duration of Internship?

After passing Part 2 of the German Medical Licensing Examination, the students complete a practical year at a clinic. They work in surgery, internal medicine and on a ward of their choice.

5. Question - Can an Indian student obtain a license to practice in Germany and is this at par with the Registration granted to local citizens in Germany?

6. Question - What is the complete Process of Registration in Germany?
