Dear Mr. Ravi Kumar,

The answer provided in our FAQs is very clear as to the conditions required for an Indian citizen to practice medicine in Mauritius.

An Indian citizen can not sit for a licensing exam in Mauritius directly, that is available only for Mauritian citizens.

A Indian citizen, if he wishes to practice medicine in Mauritius, has to get registered with the Medical council of India first and then come back to Mauritius after obtaining a work permit (job offer) from Mauritius.
