

### **Information for prospective Indian medical students**

- (1) Duration of undergraduate General Medicine program in Russia is six years. It comprises a total of twelve semesters, with two each in a year.
- (2) Students in Russian medical universities undergo clinical rotation/clerkship for twelve months or more during their course.
- (3) A number of Russian medical universities impart education in English. However, Indian students need to be proficient in Russian language to undergo practical training which includes interaction with patients who communicate in vernacular language.
- (4) The diploma awarded by Russian medical universities bear registration number of the competent Russian authority. Students need to clear accreditation examination conducted in Russian language after the final examination in order to be eligible to obtain certificate of license for medical practice in Russia.
